Environmental Factors	
•	Lack of private space for vulnerable populations (homeless, elderly, adolescent/parent)
•	Difficulty sharing sensitive health information (HIV, behavior health, contraception) remotely
•	Videoconferencing may inadvertently expose the patient's living conditions to the provider
Technological Factors	
•	Technology data security issues (hacking of video visit)
•	Limited access to internet and technology
•	Lack of digital devices, cellular data, or Wi-Fi
•	Digital literacy
•	Poor quality of audio or video
Operational Factors	
•	Privacy and security concerns
•	Reimbursement, payer denials
•	Technology accessibility
•	Training and education
•	Maintenance and updating devices
